This Annual Report is an opportunity to introduce myself to you, I'm Frank lentile, and I'm thrilled to be the new Executive Director of SSI. Together with Bob Kroll, Chair of the Board of Directors we are pleased to share with you the changes and achievements of The Speech & Stuttering Institute over the past year.

We are honoured to be a part of this organization and witness firsthand the life changing speech and stuttering therapy being conducted here. Last year our small and highly skilled team of professionals treated over 400 people (85% of those were children and youth). Of the over 4,700 visits those clients made here, one story stands out in particular:

In our Summer Intensive Fluency Program the therapist asked each of the youths to say what they hoped to get out of the therapy. One teen struggled more than the others to communicate, and his simple goal was heartbreaking. "I just want to be able to say my name."

Can you imagine how hard it is for him not being able to do what so many of us take for granted? You may know exactly what I mean; you know the frustration of not being able to speak fluently, or not understanding your child when they are trying to talk. We are so grateful we were able to help that young man not only say his name, but give him the tools to help improve his speech and confidence to take with him to high school, and throughout his life. Not only is The Speech & Stuttering Institute helping people find their voice and transform their lives directly through our clinical programs, we are continuing to make an impact by educating other Speech Language Pathologists throughout the province. Last year our senior professional staff trained over 800 professionals.

Unfortunately, the drastic cuts in government funding in the last few years have posed a challenge to SSI. This has had a devastating effect on our clinical programs as we strive to ensure excellence in care while continuing to keep the fees affordable and offering subsidies to families in need. With the help of you, an important member of our community, we are transforming The Speech & Stuttering Institute to the next level. As part of our strategic plan, we are taking concrete steps to self sustainability. We are grateful for your support. With your help we can transform lives for lasting change and continue to help people find their voice.






REVENUE BY TYPE

CLINICAL PROGRAMS

SPEECH PROGRAMS

Imagine you're a parent who cannot understand what your child is saying. This is a daily experience for families of children with speech sound disorders. Our speech programs are intensive and motor based. Our treatment approach considers how a child moves different parts of the mouth as they attempt to produce speech sounds. Therapy develops the child's control of the physical movements required to produce speech in functional words and phrases the child needs to acquire. Therapy activities are designed to provide children with many opportunities to develop and practice new speech skills while also supporting language and early literacy development. We provide individual therapy for children.

Our team of speech-language pathologists has extensive clinical and teaching experience in the following areas:

- Articulation difficulties
- Speech sound disorders
- Motor speech impairments
- Childhood Apraxia of Speech (CAS)

STUTTERING PROGRAMS

Stuttering is a chronic neurological condition that usually begins between the ages of 3 and 6 and often persists through adulthood. Stuttering affects approximately one out of every 100 persons. We provide a comprehensive range of services to individuals who stutter and their families. We offer parent based programs for preschoolers, individual and group therapy for school aged children and intensive courses for teens and adults. We teach a variety of strategies and techniques to help our clients deal with the physical and psychological effects and become successful communicators.

Our stuttering programs are:

Preschool Program (2-5yrs)

Individual therapy or parent monitoring/consultation

School-age Program (5-13 yrs)

Individual or group therapy

3-week* summer fluency program for 10-14 yr olds

→ Teen Programs (13 - 17 yrs)

Individual therapy, 3-week* intensive or weekly group treatment

*Our 3-week intensive program is internationally recognized

RESEARCH AND EDUCATION

As a part of our three-fold mandate, The Speech & Stuttering Institute engages in state of the art research to identify effective treatment methods. Research at SSI focuses on clinically relevant questions designed to shed light on best practices in the provision of Speech-Language Pathology services for individuals with speech and stuttering disorders. SSI is well-placed to draw upon the expertise of its many experienced Speech-Language Pathologists in working with these client populations.

Clinicians at the Institute are leaders in projects sponsored by the Ontario Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services aimed at developing treatment approaches for children with motor speech and stuttering disorders. This year we continued our Ministry funded provincial training project creating speech and stuttering guidelines and training speech language pathologists within the Preschool Speech and Language Services Program across Ontario. We provided education to over 550 professionals throughout 20 cities and regions. In addition, we offered our unique professional training workshops to over 250 SLPs outside of the Preschool Speech and Language Service program.
