MODELLING  Provide the child with a model of how to say a target word/phrase.	<ul> <li>Understand what to model</li> <li>Make eye contact with child and draw attention to mouth and movement</li> <li>Decrease rate of production</li> </ul>	Child tries to imitate parent's model.	<ul><li>Understands</li><li>Using with support</li><li>Using independently</li></ul>
ELICITING  Create opportunities for the child to say the word/phrase.	<ul> <li>Provide model and wait for child to imitate</li> <li>Provide a choice</li> <li>Have child fill in the blank</li> <li>Ask a question</li> </ul>	Child will produce the target word.	<ul><li>Understands</li><li>Using with support</li><li>Using independently</li></ul>
CUEING/FEEDBACK  Provide cues/feedback that help the child say the word/phrase more accurately.	<ul> <li>Judge accuracy of child's production</li> <li>Model with decreased rate</li> <li>Simultaneous production</li> <li>Provide verbal cue</li> <li>Provide visual cue</li> <li>Provide gestural cue</li> <li>Give knowledge of performance</li> <li>Give knowledge of results</li> </ul>	Child will produce the target word more accurately.	<ul><li>Understands</li><li>Using with support</li><li>Using independently</li></ul>

Types of Home Practice Activities	Child Expectations	Parent Skills
Structured activity with limited response options (e.g. Home Practice sheets).	Child will produce target word in highly structured situation where there are limited response options.	<ul> <li>Can run the activity</li> <li>Models</li> <li>Elicits</li> <li>Cues/provides feedback</li> <li>Can engage and motivate child</li> </ul>
Structured naturalistic activity with several response options (e.g. book, craft, game, etc.).	Child will produce word or phrase in a structured activity where there are several response options	<ul> <li>Can run the activity</li> <li>Models</li> <li>Elicits</li> <li>Cues/provides feedback</li> <li>Can engage and motivate child</li> </ul>
Daily routine or specific activity that provides child with the opportunity to use target word/phrase (e.g. bath time, getting dressed, meal time, etc.).	Child will produce word/phrase in a specific daily routine or activity where s/he knows the target is expected.	<ul> <li>Can set up the routine/situation</li> <li>Models</li> <li>Elicits</li> <li>Cues/provides feedback</li> <li>Can engage and motivate child</li> </ul>
A specific conversational situation where the parent monitors the child's speech and reminds child to use a target that they can produce independently.  Child will produce word/phrase accurately with minimal cueing from the parent (e.g. parent gives choice or asks for clarification "Pardon?" or models target when child makes an error).		<ul> <li>Can monitor child's speech in conversation</li> <li>Can identify correct/incorrect productions</li> <li>Can provide feedback that cues child to self monitor &amp; self correct</li> <li>Can engage and motivate child</li> </ul>
